### WHY TOGAF CERTIFICATION?

- Provides a strong incentive for organizations to standardize on TOGAF as the open method for EA
- Certified individuals have a body of core knowledge about TOGAF as an open, industry standard framework & method for EA
- An important step in making EA a well-recognized discipline
- The Open Group publishes a definitive directory of TOGAF Certified individuals, and certified service and product offerings

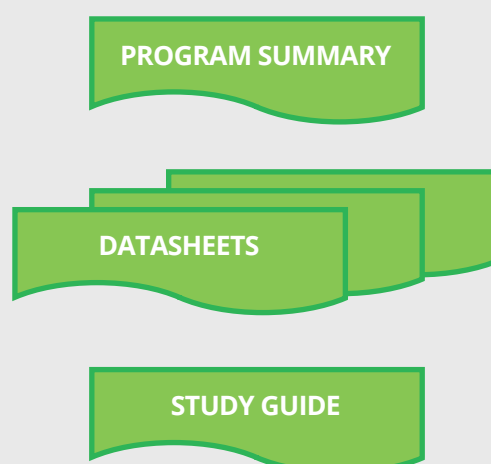
### DOCUMENTATION

- Some of these documents – like the Study Guide – are aimed at people who want to become certified; others are intended for trainers, exam developers, and the Certification Authority.

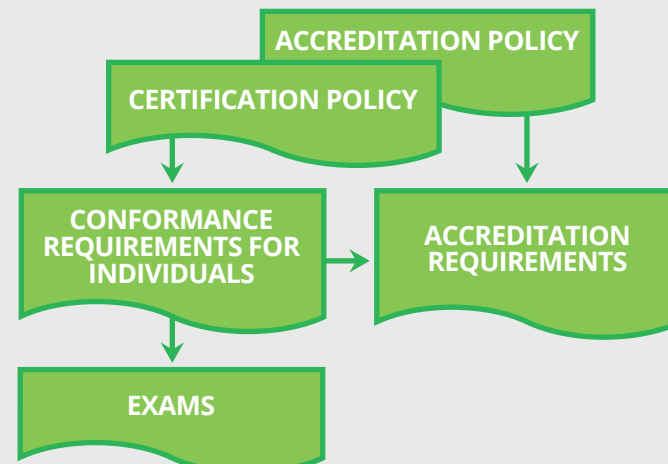

### THE 2 LEVELS OF CERTIFICATION

#### LEVEL 1: Foundation

- Level 1 certification – known as TOGAF Foundation – is the entry level
- Provides an acceptable level of knowledge about the terminology, structure, and basic concepts of TOGAF 9.1. This includes understanding the core principles of Enterprise Architecture & the TOGAF standard. The focus at Level 1 is knowledge and comprehension.
- Learning outcomes for Level 1 Foundation

#### LEVEL 2: Certified

- Level 2 certification – known as TOGAF Certification – provides validation that in addition to knowledge and comprehension, a candidate is able to analyze and apply knowledge of TOGAF
- You can take the TOGAF exams in 2 steps: Level 1, followed by Level 2. You can also take a combined exam: Level 1 with Level 2.
